THEATRE BRANCH ADMISSION

The format of the workshops for 2010 has been updated and we will be offering four, 20 minute, IDTA syllabus "taster" classes, each followed by a workshop showing how the IDTA syllabus can be utilised or developed. We will also be offering two alternative dance style workshops, Street and a finale class. Anyone may participate in the IDTA syllabus taster classes (20 minutes) subject to floor space being available (no need to book). Members and students may select up to 2 out of the 3 morning workshops and 2 out of the 3 afternoon workshops to participate in and may watch all the workshops during the day (workshops are numbered 1 - 6).

Entry to the Theatre Branch workshops is free to IDTA members on presentation of their current membership card. If you wish to spectate you do not need to book a place, please show your 2010 membership card on entry to the Westbourne Suite. Space on the floor is limited, so anyone wishing to participate in the workshops (member or student) must book their place in advance. If you or your students (maximum of three students per member) would like to take part in the workshops please complete the booking form below indicating which workshops you would like to take part in and the number of tickets required. Tickets to participate in the lectures must be booked in advance and will not be available on the door. Member's tickets are free but must be pre-booked in order for a place to be allocated on the floor.

Students must be 16 years or over or hold a current Intermediate Performers Card. Students aged 13-15 years may attend to watch the lectures only. Student ticket price £15.00 per person to perform or spectate. Non-members are welcome to spectate, tickets £15.00 per person. Provisional members ticket price £7.50 per person to perform or spectate. Please return the completed form to IDTA Head Office with a cheque for the appropriate amount made payable to 'IDTA Ltd'. If you are unsure of the total price of your order please forward the booking form and an invoice will be sent to you, alternatively please telephone Carol at Head Office on 01273 685652.

Everyone participating in the lectures will be issued with a coloured wristband (their ticket), one for each class. Members and students, who have booked to participate in a class(es), may watch the alternative classes as spectators. There will be tiered seating in addition to seating around the floor, plus large projection screens, all of which we hope will improve your view of the classes. A coffee bar area will be located in the Westbourne Suite for delegates who wish to catch up with friends or a break from the lectures.
