PROFESSIONAL SYLLABUS - AMERICAN SMOOTH

Please read carefully the details regarding professional examinations given in this syllabus.

Associate and Licentiate American Smooth examinations for <u>candidates already qualified</u> <u>and hold a full IDTA Ballroom qualification</u>, in the level applied for.

DEMONSTRATION

Candidates will be required to dance with a partner to music the four American Smooth dances; Waltz, Tango, Foxtrot and Viennese Waltz to a standard appropriate to the level of the examination being taken. The majority of figures used should be selected from those included in the relevant syllabus.

SOLO DEMONSTRATION TO MUSIC

Candidates will be required to dance solo to music, whilst giving the timing, an amalgamation of three figures in two dances selected by the Examiner from the Associate syllabus. This will include starting a class to music. For Licentiate examinations, the figures maybe from both the Associate and Licentiate syllabus.

THEORY

The technique and theory required is that described in the American Smooth Technique by Sehyoung Jang Ph.D and Adele Jang Fellow (AKA: Dr. Jang and Adele Don).

During the technical section of the examination, candidates will be asked to dance selected figures from the syllabus solo giving the count for each figure.

Full descriptions of figures or technical information confined to one column heading at a time <u>will not</u> be required. All figures selected by the Examiner must be demonstrated whilst giving the correct timing.

It is important that these solo demonstrations are presented using accurate technique since the quality achieved will be reflected in the marks awarded in this section.

TEACHING ABILITY

During the course of the examination the candidate's ability to teach will be assessed. Teaching Ability will be marked separately and will affect the result of the examination.

ASSOCIATE AMERICAN SMOOTH (60 mins)

DEMONSTRATION

Candidates will be required to dance with a partner to music, the four American Smooth dances; Waltz, Tango, Foxtrot and Viennese Waltz to a standard appropriate to the level of examination being taken. The majority of the figures used should be selected from those included in the Associate syllabus.

SOLO DEMONSTRATION TO MUSIC

Candidates will be required to dance solo to music, whilst giving the timing, an amalgamation of three figures in two dances selected by the Examiner from the Associate syllabus. This will include starting a class to music.

THEORY

Candidates will be required to have a thorough knowledge of the figures in the Associate syllabus. Candidates will be required to dance a selection of the syllabus figures solo whilst giving the timing of step numbers.

Candidates will be required to demonstrate their ability to apply the following principles in respect of each dance and figure as Leader (man) and Partner (lady): Poise, Balance, Feet Positions, Footwork, Alignment, Amount of Turn, Rise and Fall, CBM, CBMP, Sway, Timing and Dance Position.

Candidates will be asked to explain the American Smooth Dance Positions, Connections, Distance and Lines relevant to the figures listed in this syllabus. Knowledge of Precedes and Follows will be required.

TEACHING ABILITY

During the course of the examination the candidate's ability to teach will be assessed. Teaching Ability will be marked separately and will affect the result of the examination.
